Allison	Hugh, Jesse Allison's father is believed to be buried here.
Allison	Jesse; died 26 Mar 1860; aged 69 years, 5 months, days
Allison	John L., brother of Jesse Allison is believed to be buried here
Allison	Louella; died 25 Aug 1872; aged 2 years, 4 months, 12 days
Allison	Mary née Foley is buried here, wife of Jesse Allison. There is a grave beside Jesse's marked only with a rough limestone.
Bruce	Granville P.; died 30 Apr 1874; aged 42 years; husband of Sarah Elizabeth née Ellis Bruce (born 21 Dec 1833 and died 12 May 1864)
Hindman	Nathaniel T.; died 14 Apr 1863; aged 6 years, 2 months, 2 days; son of H. G. and M. Hindman
Potter	Edward L.; born 10 Sep 1873 died 27 Apr 1874; son of G. R. and H. A. Potter
Potter	Webster G.; infant son of G. R. and H. A. Potter; born 05 Dec 1870; died 14 Oct 1871
Unknown	Ten graves marked only with rough limestones. It is not possible at this time to determine whether or not they are adults or childrens' graves.
Unknown	Two graves (?); headstones carried away by local farmers.
