Reference: "History of Cooper County, Missouri" by Johnson - A daughter of Jacob and Mary nee' Parks Baughman, Rebecca was married to Judge Andrew B. Cole. They are buried in the Pisgah Baptist Cemetery.

Additional information possible burial of Jacob and his wife, Mary nee' Parks Baughman from the History of Cooper County Missouri by Johnson, page 1085; "Jacob and Mary nee' Parks Baughman are both now deceased, and their remains are buried on the Old Baughman home farm." In the 1877 atlas Jacob Baughman owned land in Sections 5, 6, and 7 Township 46-N; R-16-W; the residence was in section 7; in the NE 1/4 of section; this is probably the site of their burial place - however, no cemetery symbol marks this site. Section 7 is about 3 1/2 miles west and a little south of the site of Old Pisgah Village - which has practically disappeared.

Recent research gives the location of this cemetery as being in Township 47-N, Range 17-W, Section 23, and SW Quarter of section as the farm where the old family burial plot was located. The new information is from Mrs. Alma Baughman, whose husband was a great grandson of Jacob Baughman.

She said that she can recall the large marker at this burial plot; that when her son accompanied her to this farm, she felt sure that she could go directly to that spot where the grave was located. But to her disappointment, after much walking about, they found no traces of the burial site. She said that this site was not farming land, but was rocky and rough and did not appear to have been disturbed by bull-dozing or such operations.
