History:

"Bunceton Masonic Cemetery, Bunceton, Mo." From the "Bunceton Centennial, 1868-1968"

"As we think of the hundredth anniversary of the settlement of Bunceton, Mo., our minds reflect to the beginning of the way of living - the problems which the early settlers faced and the necessities which they encountered - they were mindful that there had to be a place to lay their loved ones to rest.

The old "City Cemetery" is located in the southwest corner of what is now the Bunceton Masonic Cemetery. We are told that the entrance was from the west, a road leading to it from the old creek road which went to Boonville. As it was not cared for by an organization, the Bunceton Masonic Lodge had a vision to take over the care of the grounds. A committee was appointed to write the by-laws, and submit them to the Lodge, which were accepted. The Lodge elected a "Board of Control" composed of three Masons who take care of the cemetery business.

The Masons take much pride in it and have made many improvements. They built a substantial fence around it and a gravel road through it. Three entrances were made on the east and trees planted along this side, all of which add to the appearance.

Mr. J. W. Wilson planted peonies at the corners of many lots and on Memorial Day, they make a beautiful cemetery as there are always some blooms and often each plant is filled with gorgeous blossoms. Later, Mr. Sam T. Smith planted many more, as the cemetery grew. There are beautiful trees; two large ones located in the central part, under which the annual program on Memorial Day is given.

The lodge hires a caretaker who keeps the grass mowed, the leaves raked, trash hauled away and digs the graves. A new tool house and rest rooms were added several years ago. They also laid a cement walk on the outside of the east fence.

It is customary for the lodge to arrange an appropriate program for Memorial Day. It is like "Home-coming" with friends and loved ones there to decorate the graves of those who have gone on before. Everyone is proud to have such an attractive resting place for their loved ones. The Masonic Lodge expresses its solemnity in this project which they have so beautifully perfected."

"The Cemetery Walk"

On June 3, 1910, there appeared an editorial in the Bunceton Tribune complimenting the Bunceton Thursday Club, a group of fine progressive women, upon undertaking the project of building a cemetery walk extending from the residential area of Bunceton, to the southeast corner of the cemetery.

For years, the people of Bunceton were compelled to make a circuitous trip in order to reach the "Silent City" where duty called them in sorrow or to witness Memorial Day exercises, so the building of the cemetery walk was hailed with delight.

In May 1910, the Bunceton Thursday Club, assisted by other ladies, had started serving many suppers to raise the money. Also generous donations were made to the project. In May, 1912, 1080 feet of the walk had been laid, with only 65 feet remaining to be done.

As time passed, the walk was neglected until about 30 years ago when the church Women's Federation decided to take care of the walk as one of its projects. A "Cemetery Walk Committee" was appointed. Each spring, the walk is cleaned of weeds, cut, and the grass is mowed. The walk bridge has been repaired several times by men who donate their labor. The cared for walk greatly adds to the appearance of the road"
