History:

This list recorded by Mr. Henry Alex Nixon, December 1966 and is corrected through December 1984. Additions in red are from the Cooper County Record of Deaths.

There are also unmarked graves here. Graves marked for Spadley and Meeky Campbell were enclosed with a cement wall; one side of the wall has fallen down. The grave marked for Bradley, son of J. L. and N. E. Campbell was at one end of the cement wall, on the outside. Graves marked for the Williamson children were about 15 to 30 feet from the others. These graves were all located beside an Indian Mound.
