History:

This cemetery is in very poor condition (1980); appears not to have been cared for, for many years. We found only a few markers. There may be more graves here without markers. This is a colored cemetery.

This cemetery was recorded by a couple wishing to remain anonymous and Mrs. Estelle Snow, assisted by Mrs. Dorsey Scot in 1980. Mrs. Scott directed the recorders to this plot and identified the cemetery as being on Embry land. There may be a later burial in this plot.

Clay	Anna; born 01 Jun 1863 in Missouri; died 28 Nov 1919 in Kelley Township, Cooper County, Missouri; buried 29 Nov 1919; daughter of Henry (born Missouri) and Unknown née Jackson Clay (born South Carolina); single; negro; housework; informant Willie Clay, Bunceton, Missouri
Clay	Faye E.; born 07 Aug 1902; died 07 Jul 1903
Clay	George; born 14 Apr 1884 in Missouri; died 23 Dec 1910 in North Moniteau Township, Cooper County, Missouri; buried 25 Dec 1910; son of Henry (born Missouri) and Ellen née Carter Clay (born Missouri); single; farm laborer; negro; informant Willis Clay, Bunceton, Missouri
Clay	Henry, Rev.; born 15 Aug 1836; died 14 Mar 1902
Clay	Kuegata Koriss; born 21 Dec 1907 in Bunceton, Missouri; died 21 Dec 1910 in Bunceton, Missouri; buried 22 Dec 1920; son of August (born Cooper County, Missouri) and Myrtle née Washington Clay (born Cooper County, Missouri); negro; informant August Clay, Bunceton, Missouri
Jackson	John; born 01 Jul 1811; died 22 Jul 1871
Jackson	Mariah; died 08 Sep 1869
Robinson	Anthony; born circa 1895; died 26 Jul 1907; son of John Robinson; a negro farmer living near Cotton, Cooper County, Missouri
Unknown	Footstone "F. E. C."; no dates; likely this is an additional entry for Faye E. Clay
