Ellis	Mary Ann Ellis, wife of Colin Johnson is buried in the Old Beulah Church Cemetery near Syracuse. She was a sister of William Ellis. Both she and William were born at Pine Park, Orange, Virginia. They are the maternal grandparents of "Will Heir". William Ellis and Louisa Duke were "Will Heir's" paternal grandparents. Louisa Duke is buried somewhere in Virginia as she died before William came to Missouri. William's third wife, Nancy, a sister of Colin Johnson came with him to Missouri. Also a daughter, 10 years of age, Martha Gray by his second wife, Ann Richardson. His oldest son Thomas J. (called Joe), William Henry (Rylie's grandpa) (the Doctor), a daughter Mary by his first wife Louisa Duke came with him. A married daughter Elizabeth and husband (David Patterson) had come the year before and settled on what is now the place of Emmett Scotts (1977)

Jackson	Charles; born in Missouri; died 09 Jul 1884 in Prairie Home Township, Cooper County, Missouri; aged 19 years, 5 months, 20 days; single; black; house servant
Jackson	Just over the fence on the West side are the graves of two slaves "Aunt Dorcus" and "Charlie" Jackson, a youngster taken for the "poor farm". There may be others. The field stones used to mark these graves have been destroyed through the years and the graves can no longer be located.

McPhatridge	Mamie L. née Ellis; born 06 Aug 1853; died 01 Feb 1923; daughter of William H. and Ann M. née Johnson Ellis; wife of Henry P. McPhatridge
Miller	Fannie Louisa; born 20 Aug 1852; died 1858; daughter of P. B. and M. L. Miller
Miller	Peter Robb; born 03 Feb 1819; died 10 Sep 1850
Patterson	David J.; born 25 Apr 1915; died 02 Jan 1845
