Brock	Thomas; died 1822; first husband of Malinda née Ramsey Brock Ellis; married 1821
Dillard	Joseph; 27 Mar 1823; died 31 Jan 1891 in Pettis County, Missouri; son of William and Jane née Williams Dillard; husband of Mary Elizabeth née Kindred Ellis Dillard; is also listed in the Ellis Cemetery in Pettis County, Missouri
Dillard	Mary Elizabeth Kindred née Ellis; born 04 Jan 1838; died 02 Mar 1923 in Hughesville, Missouri; daughter of J. and M. Ellis; wife of Joseph Dillard; is also listed in the Ellis Cemetery in Pettis County, Missouri
Ellis	Benjamin Franklin; born 1810-1815 (these dates in question); son of Isaac Spencer and Martha "Patsey" née Shipley Ellis
Ellis	Eleanor née Hughes; born 14 Dec 1810 in Tennessee; died 01 Sep 1887 in Cooper County, Missouri; daughter of Reece and Sarah Elizabeth née Murphy Hughes; wife of William Shipley Ellis
Ellis	George Shipley; born 17 Sep 1810 in Barren County, Kentucky; died 1850; son of Isaac Spencer and Martha "Patsey" née Shipley Ellis; husband of Mary née Bradley Ellis
Ellis	Isaac Spencer, born 16 Jul 1780 in North Carolina; died Dec 1859 in Cooper County, Missouri (Not old enough for service in Revolutionary War but was in the War of 1812); son of Isaac; born 1760 and Elizabeth née McCord Spencer Ellis (?); information on parentage is disputed and parents are also given as Benjamin and Rachel née Presnell Ellis; buried on home place in Clear Creek Township. One owner of the land indicated they were buried in the plot of land close to the small existing barn (2003). His information was from his father or grandfather but that is all just tradition; husband of Martha "Patsey" née Shipley Ellis
Ellis	Isaac Spencer, Sr.; born Virginia 1760; came to Missouri and settled in Clear Creek Township in 1818; Died in 1840 and was buried on his own homestead and a rock marks his grave; Possibly buried here or on another farm in Clear Creek Township
Ellis	James Ramey; born 06 Aug (or Mar) 1832; died 03 Feb 1909 (or 1908); husband of Mary Cole Dillard; married 25 Aug 1853 in Pettis County, Missouri; is also listed in the Ellis Cemetery in Pettis Coutu

Ellis	John Wick; born 07 Jan 1807 in Barren County, Kentucky; died 26 Nov 1898 in Pettis County, Missouri; husband of Malinda Jane née Ramey (Brock) Ellis; married 25 Nov 1829 in Saline County, Missouri; John Wick Ellis is not buried in this Ellis Cemetery but in the Ellis Cemetery in Pettis County, Missouri where a double headstone exists for John Wick and Malinda Jane née Ramey (Brock) Ellis.
Ellis	Malinda Jane née Ramey (Brock); born 10 Jun 1810 Clark County, Kentucky; died 30 Jan 1887 in Pettis County, Missouri; daughter of James Stephen and Elizabeth Jean née Kindred Ramey; wife of John Wick Ellis; married 25 Nov 1829 in Saline County, Missouri; Malinda Jane née Ramey (Brock) Ellis is not buried in this Ellis Cemetery but in the Ellis Cemetery in Pettis County, Missouri where a double headstone exists for John Wick and Malinda Jane née Ramey (Brock) Ellis.
Ellis	Martha "Patsey" née Shipley; born 28 May 1785 in Kentucky; died 22 Mar 1862 in Cooper County, Missouri; daughter of George and Elizabeth née McCord Shipley; buried on home place in Clear Creek Township. One owner of the land indicated they were buried in the plot of land close to the small existing barn (2003). His information was from his father or grandfather but that is all just tradition; wife of Isaac Spencer Ellis
Ellis	Mary G. "Polly" née Dillard; born 24 Dec 1831; died 24 Aug 1905; daughter of William and Jane nee Williams Dillard; wife of James Ramsey Ellis; married 25 Aug 1823 in Pettis County, Missouri; is also listed in the Ellis Cemetery in Pettis County, Missouri
Ellis	William Shipley; born 16 Apr 1808 in Barren County, Kentucky; died 27 May 1889 in Pilot Grove, Missouri; hit by a train at Pilot Grove, Missouri; husband of Eleanor née Hughes Ellis; married 07 Sep 1829 in Cooper County, Missouri
Leftwich	Elizabeth Kindred née Ellis; born 02 Jul 1828; died 1850; wife of John Wesley Leftwich; married 27 Aug 1845 in Cooper County, Missouri; daughter of Isaac Spencer and Martha "Patsey" née Shipley Ellis. [John Wesley Leftwich; born 04 Feb 1826 in Virginia; died 17 Jul 1887 in Pettis County, Missouri; son of William Burwell and Sarah née Smith Leftwich, husband of Elizabeth Kindred née Ellis Leftwich, first wife; husband of Devereaux Ball Travis Glasscock [born 11 Dec 1825; died 03 May 1889; buried Salem Cemetery, Pettis County, Missouri] is buried in Salem Cemetery, Pettis County, Missouri]
