Directions:

About one mile west of Mt. Herman Church on Route B, south of Boonville. Located on the range line between the Robert Bail land and the Johnny Whitehorse land, but on the Bail land.

Atlas Survey:

1877 Land Atlas – a cemetery symbol at this location on the A. H. and J. Greenhalgh land, along the range line. Rudolph land adjoins this on the west; cemetery in on the Greenhalgh land.

1915 Land Atlas – no cemetery symbol on Peter Hein land – Rudolph land adjoins on the west.

1978 Plat Book – no cemetery symbol on the Fred Bail land – Nora Grissum land on west.

1991 Plat Book – no cemetery symbol on Robert Bail land – Johnny Whitehorse land on west.

History:

This cemetery is almost inaccessible from any public road and is in very poor condition; overgrown with weeds, brush and wild grape vines. The stone are in good condition; most of them still standing; but those lying on the ground are in danger of being lost under the accumulation of leaves and dirt, etc. There is a good fence around it.

During his lifetime, Mr. Edgar Rudolph cared for this cemetery, but at present and for some time past, it has had no care.

It was established on the homestead of A. H. and J. Greenhalgh.
