Directions:

Road Directions: From Clark's Fork, go east and north on Route y about 2 1/2 miles to intersection (1st) with gravel road; turn east (right) on gravel road and go only about 1/4 mile to another gravel road; turn south (right) and go to the end of this road, about 1 mile. The cemetery is in this area, about half - quarter mile into the field.

Atlas Survey:

History:

This piece of ground, which is fenced, is about 90 feet, running North and South, and about 60 running east and west. It is not near any road now in use. This cemetery is in very bad condition. On 16 Feb 1994, Mary Ann Kempf and her son, John, visited this burial plot and copied all available data on the markers. This was land was sold before 1994 to someone in St. Louis, Missouri.

Hale	George; born in Missouri; died 22 Sep 1884 in Saline Township, Cooper County, Missouri; aged 1 year, 4 months, 10 days; buried 23 Sep 1884; CC Record of Deaths
Hale	Mary C.; born 1835; died 11 Nov 1883; aged 48 years, 9 months, 18 days; wife of G. C. Hale; "As a wife, devoted; as a mother, affectionate; as a friend, ever kind and true." ; "In life, she exhibited all the Graces of a Christian. In death, her redeemed spirit returned to God who gave it."
