"Paul Whitley willed his property to his wife for her life and, at her death, it was to go to the public schools of an area now comprising Moniteau Township, Cooper County. The widow, with her nephew, Lewis Reed, moved to Texas in 1851. Returning in 1855, she died of cholera on a steamboat and was buried on a bank of the Mississippi River near Vicksburg. Before her death, she intrusted to slave woman she owned, \$2000 in gold. The slave woman, with a Negro man, later known as Alex Crum because he was bought by Anderson Crum of Moniteau County and several slave children, returned to Pisgah, Cooper County. There, the Negro woman turned over to David Jones, executor of the Whitley estate, the gold she had carried in a belt around her waist, and
AA/s ideals and	surrendered herself and the children to be sold. Proceeds from the slave sale were applied to the fund, in all amounting to \$13,000. In 1910, the Cooper County court, appropriated \$1,000 to remove Paul Whitley's body to Harris Cemetery, south of Prairie Home and to erect an impressive monument. The court also set aside \$300, interest from which is used for permanent upkeep of the grave."
