From Interstate 70 take Highway 87 south. Go 10 miles to Prairie Home. Turn Right onto J and go 5 miles to O and turn left Cemetery is less than a mile. The Christian cemetery is to the left next to the road and is unfenced)

Boswell	Captain; a Confederate Officer killed in the Civil War, in Oct of 1864 at Prairie Home, Missouri, near the old Tompkins Inn. Buried in an unmarked grave in Pisgah Cemetery". Note: This account from Johnson's "History of Cooper County, Missouri". It is not known if he was buried in this cemetery or in the Pisgah Baptist Cemetery, now known as "Pisgah Cemetery" just across the road from this cemetery.
