History:

According to the Providence Baptist Church records, the first burial in this cemetery was in 1882. There are some unknown graves here and a few colored children are buried in the northwest corner of the cemetery.

This cemetery was recorded by Mr. William Don Carlos in 1962. This cemetery was also recorded by the Church of Jesus Christ of Latter Day Saints by Fannie and Katherine on 06 Jun 1961. Their additions or changes along with changes from Linda Imhoff or any changes or additions from the original recording are given in [blue](#). Entries in [orange](#) are from the State of Missouri Death Records.

This cemetery is now (2004) administered by the Providence Cemetery Association which meets annual. There is a plat map located in the caretaker's building. Linda Imhoff, secretary of the Cemetery Association is in the process of updating the records to this site.

HISTORY OF PROVIDENCE CEMETERY PRAIRIE HOME, MISSOURI September 26, 1997

The Providence Cemetery Association met on Sunday, September 9, 1956 with around 50 people present. Officers and directors at that time were the following:

President--J. C. Hornbeck

Vice President--L. L. Kirschman

Secretary/Treasurer--Mrs. J. P. Schilb

Directors were L. L. Kirschman, J. W. Kirschman and Walter L. Dungan

The caretaker at that time was Sterling Fain. The treasurer's report shows a balance on hand of \$65.74 and a certificate of deposit in the amount of \$300.

In 1957, there was a savings bond that came due in the amount of \$750. Albert Hornbeck had it in his possession and he was to reinvest it in a certificate of deposit. Members voted to have caretaker remove some surplus dirt from the graves. In 1958, it was voted to buy some lumber to have some tables made for the meeting.

In 1960, approximately 75 people attended and they had a balance on hand in the checking

account of \$159.74 and \$1,000 in certificate of deposit. Mr. Albert Hornbeck replaced Mr. J. C. Hornbeck as President. Lester Kirschman was reelected Vice President and Lillian Schilb elected Secretary/Treasurer.

In 1961, Perry Dungan was buried.

In 1962, Hattie Bottoms and Olind L. Pursley were buried.

In 1963, Arthur Adair and Lester Kirschman volunteered to obtain some trees to be planted for shade. Russell Adair, Hugh Kirschman and Hayden Bottoms were to plant them. Celeste Hornbeck, Addie George Johnson and Velma G. Pursley were buried in 1963.

The association voted in 1964 to paint the building, gate, post and braces. The directors of Russell Adair, Hugh Kirschman and Hayden Bottoms were to take care of the painting. William Gronstedt, Perry A. Young and Mina Simmons were buried in 1964.

At the 1965 meeting, Russell Lee Adair Jr. was elected to the board to fill the unexpired term of his deceased father, Russ Adair.

In 1966, it was voted to try to establish a perpetual fund for making the cemetery self-sustaining. Mary Lewis Adair and Lillian Schilb were to send a form letter to interested individuals explaining the fund-drive. At that time, there was \$118 in checking account and \$1,000 on time deposits.

In 1967, the association voted to become incorporated as a not-for-profit corporation. The offering that day was \$240. The money in time deposit was voted to be put in a perpetual care fund. Lilburn J. McDaniel was buried in 1967.

At the 1968 meeting, it was reported the association now has \$3,000 on time deposit at the Cooper County Savings and Loan Association and \$224.47 in checking account at Kemper State Bank. Mr. Hampton Tisdale, Attorney at Law was checking on the deed to see if we could incorporate. A committee consisting of Agnes Bottoms, Hugh Kirschman and Virginia Dungan was appointed to put up a sign with the name of Providence Cemetery. Josephine Simmons Dungan McDaniel and Minnie Alice Wisdom were buried in 1968.

In 1969, Walter L. Dungan was elected President, J. W. Kirschman; Vice President and Mary Lewis Adair as Secretary/Treasurer for the 1969-70 year. The directors were Arthur Adair, Hayden Bottoms and Russell Adair.

On September 13, 1970, the annual meeting was held at the Prairie Home Baptist Church due to rain. There were 44 people in attendance. The Treasurer's report showed a balance of \$3,000 on time deposit, \$397.88 in savings account and \$86.50 in checking. According to the records, \$2,000 was raised between 1966-1970. Mr. Paul Wooldridge, Attorney at Law met with the members and explained the by-laws and legal procedure to become incorporated. The association filed Articles of Incorporation with the Secretary of State's office as a general not-for-profit corporation. Judy Bottoms Burks and Edna Pauline Deuel were buried in 1970.

The minutes are missing from the year 1971-1975.

On September 12, 1976, President Walter L. Dungan presided over the meeting. The treasurer's report still showed \$3,000 on time deposit, the savings account increased to \$1,044.00 and \$21.00 in checking. Several members asked to reserve burial plots. It was voted to let them choose their plots and record it on a numbered plot map. The members asking to reserve a plot were Betty Wisdom Summers, Mr. and Mrs. Russell Adair, Mr. and Mrs. Pick Gaston and Mr. and Mrs. Hayden Bottoms. Also, some monuments were repaired at a cost of \$65 and the directors are planning to repair the building. Officers elected were Walter Dungan, President; Jim Kirschman, Vice President; Nora Renfrow, Secretary and Mary Lewis Adair as Treasurer. Hugh Kirschman, Hayden Bottoms and Roger Dungan were elected directors.

In 1977, a memorial for Allen Johnson was named in the amount of \$1,000. By 1978, the total assets of the Providence Cemetery including interest on certificates of deposit totaled \$5,819.16.

In 1981, it was voted to combine the savings and certificates of deposit totaling \$5,000 into a money-market account for 30 months. Woodrow Simmons was buried in 1981.

Helen F. Adair was buried in 1983.

In May, 1984, we received the \$1,000 Certificate of Deposit for Allen Johnson Memorial. Dorsey Bottoms was buried in 1984.

In 1985, total assets were \$9,735.45. A motion was made and accepted to raise the mowing fee

to \$50 each time. Glen and Hugh Kirschman were appointed to see about getting a new roof for the building and have it installed. David Adair installed the roof in 1985 and Hugh and Glen Kirschman cleaned up the area following the installation. William E. Adair, James R. Wright and Mabel Hornbeck were buried in 1985.

In 1986, the Wisdom Family set up a trust fund and Providence Cemetery will receive interest from this fund. Robert Wisdom and Betty Summers are trustees for the Wisdom Family. Sterling Fain has been the caretaker since 1956 and was again asked to continue the job. Paul Clay Wisdom was buried in 1986.

In 1987, any member wanting to reserve a plot was asked to go ahead and have a marker put up. Sterling Fain was retained as caretaker with help from Robert Dungan, Jr. as needed.

In 1988, Robert Dungan, Jr. volunteered to clean up the area around the outhouse. Raymond L. Adair and Robert L. Dungan were buried.

And in 1989, Robert Dungan, Jr. was retained as caretaker. Wayne Lucas was buried in 1989.

September 9, 1990, the meeting was held with 36 members present. Gary Alpers has been retained for mowing the cemetery and will mow again for the summer of 1991 at a rate of \$50 per mowing. Officers elected were President--Walter Dungan; Vice President--Jim Kirschman; Secretary--Renea Adair Sapp, and Treasurer--Chanda Adair Widel.

In 1991, it was voted to have plot copies sent to the officers and directors. Hugh Kirschman will try to keep a current plot map available to interested parties as he has in the past.

In 1992, Ginny Adair painted the grounds building.

In 1993, there were two burials, Walter L. Dungan and Truman Dungan. Walter served continuously as President since 1969 for a total of 24 years. David Adair was elected President. Leroy F. McDaniel was elected Vice-President, Secretary--Renea Adair Sapp and Treasurer--Chanda Adair Widel. The directors are Hugh Kirschman, 3 yrs; Jim Warmbrodt, 2 yrs; and Robert Dungan, 1 yr.

In 1994, there was discussion about contacting Shirley Lucas regarding a permanent grave marker for Wayne Lucas. Also, the board of directors were to decide whether to renew or change the certificates of deposit coming due in July, 1995. Possibly, put \$10,000 to a 5 year Certificate of Deposit and the balance to 1 year certificates.

On September 10, 1995, the certificates of deposit totaled \$14,000, with the balance of the funds held in passbook savings and checking account to pay for maintenance. Linda Dungan Imhoff volunteered to create a mailing list on computer disk so a letter could be sent each year to descendants inviting them to the annual meeting and also, asking for contributions to continue to build up the perpetual fund. Russell Lee and Wilda Adair offered to post a new sign on the cemetery gate with the name and address to send contributions towards maintenance. Roy Edward Schultz was buried in 1995.

In 1996, Linda Dungan Imhoff donated her time and postage for mailing 75 letters to descendants asking for additional contributions to build up the perpetual fund. This mailing brought in several hundred dollars as it was sent to several people that live out of state. Officers were retained again for another term. Mary Lewis Adair was buried in 1996.

In 1997, there again was some discussion about obtaining a permanent marker for the grave of Wayne Lucas. Linda Dungan Imhoff contacted the Veterans Administration and obtained the necessary papers to request a marker for Wayne Lucas, however will need some information from Shirley Lucas. The Veterans Administration will provide a bronze foot stone at no cost, but we will need to pay for installing the marker at the grave site. Mrs. Frances Bottoms Smothers offered to speak to Mrs. Lucas to obtain the necessary information.

Blanch Adair Young was buried in 1997.
