Renshaw	John Wiley, Rev.; born 24 May 1818; died 19 May 1869; aged 51 Years, 5 days; husband of Margarete A. née Martin Renshaw; married 12 Oct 1835; "In memory of" and "Departed this life"
Renshaw	Margarete A. "Peggy" née Martin; born 28 Jun 1818; died 28 Aug 1896; daughter of Isham and Elizabeth née Hill Martin; wife of Rev. John Wiley Renshaw; married 12 Oct 1835
Renshaw	Martha J.; born 26 Apr 1844; died 18 Oct 1866; daughter of Rev. John Wiley and Margarete A. "Peggy" née Martin Renshaw
