

## Splice Creek Baptist Church Cemetery

**Directions:**

The Splice Creek Baptist Church is nearby; only about one quarter mile south of the cemetery at the crossroads in the northeast quarter of section 16. From Prairie Home, take Route EE north about ¾ miles; turn east (right) and go east about ½ miles. The road curves to the north and east (left); then turns due north (left). Follow about ¼ mile and take a road to the east (right); this road turns north in a short distance of about ¼ mile. Go east (right) another ½ mile then take another turn to north about ½ mile. Here the road goes by the cemetery on the right hand side of the road.

**Atlas Survey:**

1877 land atlas – no cemetery symbol in southwest quarter of section 10 on J. J. Warmbrodt land. No church symbol on J. E. Plank land in northwest quarter of section 16, near crossroads. The church was not build until 1907.

1915 land atlas – a cemetery symbol on C. M. Shepherd or J. J. Warmbrodt land. A church symbol on southeast quarter of section 16 n John F. Blank land.

1978 plat book – a cemetery symbol on William and Dale Graff land in southwest quarter of section 10, on east side of road. A church symbol in northeast quarter on William Langlotz land near the crossroads.

1991 plat book – a cemetery symbol in southwest quarter of section 10 on William Graff land and no church symbol on William Langlotz land.

**History:**

Recorded by Mrs. Olive D. Hill, church secretary. This information was given by two of the late Deacons of the church: Brother Elizie Patterson and Brother Cornelius Coleman, and the late Sister Mamie F. Miller, and many others members. The ground for the cemetery was donated by the Coleman Family. The cemetery is cared for by Mr. Wilbur Miller, with help from others of the members.
