Directions:

On a farm, fourteen miles southeast of Boonville, Missouri in the Clarks Fork Township. A private burial plot on the old Toler Homestead on the rise of the knoll just north of the residence of the Toler brothers.

History:

A single monument carries the essential data relating to those lying there and four beautiful cedar trees shade the well kept plot. From "History of Cooper County, Mo." By Mr. W. F. Johnson, 1919.

In 1987, Mrs. Warren Brandes, stated that the old Toler Family Plot was located on the Curtis Scott Farm. Mr. Brandes reported there probably 8 to 10 graves there.
