**History:**

This cemetery is no longer in existence. The last known burial was in the 1920's. The cemetery was later "plowed under" with some of the stones going to the West Boonville Evangelical Church Cemetery. The remainder of the stones were tossed over the river bluff. While the origins of the cemetery name can not be proven; it was believed that Union soldiers were buried here during the Civil War giving the cemetery its name.
