**History:**

Recorded by Mr. & Mrs. Farrie Cole, Sr.; cemetery is quite away back in the woods from the church. Other additions are changes noted in red are from the Cooper County Record of Deaths.

This list was taken from church records and was supplied by Mr. George Buckner and his sister, Dolly Buckner. Additions to it given in red were taken from the Cooper County Record of Deaths and entries in orange are from the online State of Missouri Death Records.

For many years, this cemetery was neglected and allowed to become overgrown with brush and weeds.

Sometime prior to Memorial Day, 1977, it had been nicely cleared off and mowed. Some of the graves are marked by nice monuments; and there are a number of military markers at veterans graves; flags were placed at these for Memorial Day by members of the American Legion Post.

According to Mr. Buckner's recollections, this plot of ground was given for a burial grounds by the same persons who gave the ground for the first Wesley Chapel Methodist Cemetery - Mr. Henry Schlotzhauer, Jr. This plot was used by both the churches in Pilot Grove - The A. M. E. and the Free Will Baptist Churches.
