From Boonville, Missouri at the #87 exit from I-70 Interstate, take an auxiliary road going east 3 to 4 miles. There are several jogs along this road, but where it turns north (left) towards I-70 on the left side is the Mamie Oerly land. This is where the cemetery was located.

**Atlas Survey:**

**History:**

"The George C. Honerbrink Farm has located upon it an old cemetery, established by Joseph Westbrook, who owned the farm ninety years ago, or more (early 1800's). He was the first to be buried there, and later the other members of his family were laid to rest there. Other pioneers of Cooper County have this spot for their last resting place; among them the Elliott and William Leek families. From: Johnson's "History of Cooper County, Missouri", 1919.
