

AUTHOR'S NOTE: Like any census record, some census takers had excellent handwriting and spelling, others had terrible handwriting and spelling, some were wrote down every scrap of information and others very little. This census is no different. As a result the user should be aware of misspellings and other errors; and not regard this document as being totally reliable. Always consult the original and use this document only as a guide. While the 1890 Census was designed for Union Veterans, on occasions Confederate Veterans were included but later marked off the census. I have included Confederate records when available.
