**Cemetery:** There was a cemetery associated with this church. And although the church is long gone, the cemetery remains.

**Area:** Southeast quarter of the northeast quarter of the section. From Boonville, Missouri about eighteen miles, south on Route 5; then turn right onto gravel road. The cemetery is visible from Highway 5; about 1/2 quarter mile on north (right) side of gravel road.

**Records:** Unknown at this time. Being a Presbyterian church, they would have records. But I suspect that they are as missing as the church.

### Bethlehem Cemetery By David D. Grove

In the 1877 land atlas we find a cemetery symbol on Susan Carr land, at the location where the Bethlehem Cemetery was established in 1870. Possibly this was originally a family burial plot and then was taken into the cemetery of the Bethlehem Presbyterian Church.
