Highland Church, C. P. - The Cumberland Presbyterians organized a church at Highland school house, February 20, 1867. The Rev. A. M. Thompson, assisted by Warren Compton and W. D. Mahan, officiated at the organization. The church was erected in 1870; dedicated February 12, 1883, by Rev. C. W. McBride. It is a frame building and cost \$1,600. The original members were John Fluke, Joseph Knikshire, Wm. E. Clayton, Andrew J. Roberson, Margaret Kniksire, Nancy R. Durnil, Louisa Fluke, Elizabeth Edwards, Mary L.
