**Cemetery:** There is a cemetery associated with this church.

**Area:** Southeast quarter of the northeast quarter of section west of Boonville and near intersection of Route 135 and I-70; about 1/2 mile northeast of intersection; then west.

**Records:** The records of this church were kept by Caspar Langlotz in his home. Although the records were not destroyed when the church burned, they were destroyed when the Caspar Langlotz home burned.

### History:

#### Jones Chapel

In December of 1854 Preston and Lenora M. Eades should the land for a church and cemetery to the trustees (Caleb Jones, James Franklin, N. Hutchison, and George Dorsey) of the Jones Chapel Methodist Episcopal Church South for the total of \$1. The deed which was recorded on 09 Jan 1855 notes that there is already a church standing on the land. So the Jones Chapel church was formed sometime prior to 1855.

The church was burned to the ground in 1923 and never rebuilt.
