Sixth Baptist Church (Colored), Boonville - Organized June 1, 1874, by Rev. S. Bryant. Names of original members: Green Wilson, William Jackson, David Watson, Paul Donaldson, Smith Barnes, Rebecca Sharp, Martha Tibbs, Clacy Waller, Esther Rollins, Clara Johnson, Dilcey Thomas, Sarah Jackson, Arrena Watson. Present membership, 100. First pastor, Rev. Reuben Nelson; second, Rev. J. J. Moors; third, R. M. Vernon ; fourth, Tinley T. Lucas; fifth, Rev. James Powell; present pastor, Freeman Jones. Built in 1876 cost, \$1,000; number of Sabbath school scholars, fifty; superintendent, Frank Harris.

Sixth Baptist Church, Colored, is located in Boonville and was organized in 1874 by Rev. S. Bryan. A building was erected in 1876 at a cost of \$1,000. This church had a membership of one hundred in 1883. Original members were: Green Wilson, William Jackson, David Watson, Paul Donaldson, Smith Barnes, Rebecca Sharp, Martha Tibbs, Clacy Waller, Esther Rollins, Clara Johnson, Dilcey Thomas, Sarah Jackson, Arrena Watson.
