**The MUSTER ROLL of the Field and Staff of the Boonville Battalion United States Reserve Corps; Major Jos. A. Eppstein from the first day of September 1861, when last mustered to the twenty-fourth day of March 1862**

Not received any pay up to March 24, 1862 and therfor claims pay as Major from Sep 1, 1861 to March 24th, 1862
Haas	Emil	Assistant Surgeon	Jun 20, 1861	Boonville	Maj Conans	Acted and appointed assistant surgeon from Sep 1, 1861 to Dec 4th 1861. Not received any pay for the time herein specified. The Stippage of Eighty Six (86) dollars is for money advanced by Joseph A. Eppstein with the understand that the said amount was to be refunded when the allowance of service delivered be paid.

Joseph A. Eppstein makes oath and says I am the identical Joseph A. Eppstein who was Major of the Boonville Battalion United States Reserve Corp. Missouri Volunteers (also called Boonville Home Guards) called into the military service of the United States in the Department of Missouri by order of General N. Lyon and Major General Fremont. That the above roll exhibits the true state of the Company for the person therein maintained. That the remarks opposite each officer and soldier name are accurate and true. And that the recapitulation exhibits the true state of the Officers of said Battalion and staff. I have no knowledge of any member of said Company having received pay or anything in lieu thereof either from the state or General Fremont, except as stated in said roll. That I am personally acquainted with each officer and man whose name appears in the above roll and that they are and have been each and every one of them Loyal Citizens of the United States.
