John Stone, postmaster at Clifton, has been a resident of Cooper county since 1850 and was born in Tennessee in 1833. He has been twice married.

James M. Moore, farmer, of Palestine township, is sixty-one years old, and a native of Cooper county. He has been twice married. Mr. Moore is a member of the Methodist church.
