He is a twin, but his twin brother Moses died in infancy. He married and lived in North Carolina until 1865, then moved and settled in Miami county, Ohio, where he remained three years only, then moved to Cooper county, Mo., where he remained until the present. His health is very good, but he is very feeble. He will be ninety-six years of age the 17th of May. Mrs. Wyatt is seventy-three years of age and is as sprightly as a girl. She says she is stouter and can walk farther in a day than any girl she has. To Mr. and Mrs. Wyatt has been born fifteen children, of whom twelve are living—five sons and seven daughters. Their grand-children number forty-eight, and great grand-children seventeen. Mr. Wyatt claims that he was never beat running or jumping, and was never thrown down, and never had a slight in his life.—
