✓ Samuel S. Case, for many years a citizen of Cooper county, died at the home of his son, J. S. Case, in Marshall, on Sunday, December 15, 1895, aged eighty years. The remains were brought to Nelson, Tuesday, and the funeral took place that day from the Salt Fork church to Salt Fork cemetery. Deceased leaves eight children—seven sons and one daughter.
