

DEATHS DURING THE WEEK.

—Will Otten, 23 years old, and for seven years a mail-carrier in Sedalia, died there Monday night and was buried Wednesday. He was a cousin of Frank Otten, of Boonville.

—John Cartner, who resided on his farm, seven miles south of Boonville, died on Sunday, and was buried Wednesday morning. He was about 68 years old, had lived in this county all his life, and was highly esteemed. Among his very intimate friends was Judge E. R. Hayden. Deceased left a widow and several children.
