The young people were married at the residence of William Nicholson and the ceremony was performed by the Rev. Dr. Boyd, pastor of the Methodist church at Kearney.

The ceremony was followed by an elaborate reception and marriage feast. All of the members of the family were present with the exception of Mr. and Mrs. Frank James of St. Louis. The bride is well known in Kansas City. She attended the high school here and lived with her mother at 3402 Tracy avenue until last fall, when she went to her grandmother's home near Kearney, shortly after the death of Mrs. Jesse James. Mr. Barr met the bride twelve years ago and they were engaged for several years. They will live at their pleasant country home near Kearney.
