MRS. WM. R. GEORGE.

Mrs. William R. George died Tuesday morning at her home in Bunceton. Her maiden name was Gilbreath, and she was born near Prairie Home, December 29, 1832. She was married May 24, 1853. Of the four children born, three survive: Mrs. C. A. Lee and N. A. George, of this county, and Mrs. J. A. Lee, of Bunceton. W. M. and N. A. Gilbreath are brothers, and Mrs. R. A. George and Mrs. Emily Carpenter are sisters. Deceased had been a member of the Cumberland Presbyterian church since 1849, and had all her life been a consistent Christian. The funeral services were held at 10 o'clock yesterday morning, Rev. J. W. Mitchell, of Marshall, officiating, assisted by Rev. Gordon and Rev. Ewing, of Bunceton. Interment was in the Bunceton cemetery.
