**MRS. BEN GORRELL DEAD.**

Passed Away at Home on South Osage Avenue Monday Afternoon.

Mrs. Ida Gorrell, wife of Ben Gorrell, superintendent of the Twelve Mile road district, died at 2:30 o'clock Monday afternoon at her home, 1610 South Osage avenue, after an illness of several months of a complication of diseases. Mrs. Gorrell was 33 years of age. She was the daughter of J. W. Payne, a former resident of Sedalia, but now living in St. Louis. She is survived by her husband, a daughter, Miss Fae, 11 years of age; a son, Richard Marrett, age 9 years; two sisters, Mrs. Della Haines, of Cottersville, Ill., and Mrs. Anna Mitchell, of Livingston, Mont., and one brother, Carlisle Payne, of St. Louis.

The funeral services will be held from the home Wednesday afternoon at 2 o'clock, conducted by Rev. J. F. Caskey, pastor of the Fifth Street Methodist Church, South. In this hour of bereavement Mr. Gorrell and his family will have the sympathy of the entire community.

Although not a member of any church, Mrs. Gorrell was a woman who was held in the highest esteem and who lived a Christian life in the best sense of the word. She had been ill for several months and had recently returned from a trip to Oklahoma and Texas, undertaken in the hope that her health might be benefited.
