## DR. ELSTON SERIOUSLY ILL

Word reached Jefferson City Monday that Dr. James A. Elston is seriously, if not fatally, ill at Elston, Mo. Dr. Elston is far advanced in years and his advanced age, together with his weakened physical condition, makes his recovery very improbable. He is one of the oldest physicians in the country and has practiced his profession in Elston and surrounding country many years and has been regarded as one of the ablest physicians in Central Missouri.

He built the Elston house in Jefferson City and is a man of considerable means. He has no family, his wife having died about thirty years ago. He is a brother of the late Dr. Addison Elston and also of Judge George Elston.
