Killed in Nebraska

Noble Thomas, a son of Mr. and Mrs. J. B. Thomas living southeast of Warrensburg several miles, was accidentally shot and killed at Cook, Nebraska, December 16. The body was brought to Missouri for interment. The funeral was held Saturday following the accident from the Pleasant Point church near the home of Mr. and Mrs. Thomas and in the community he had been reared. The services were in charge of Revs. Paxton and Odom. A very large concourse of friends were present. The deceased was forty-four years of age at the time of his death. He had been in the West the past five years. We have not learned particulars in regard to the accident, but the discharge of the weapon was accidental, it being in the hands of a young lady at the time. The victim of the accident was well and favorably known to a large circle of friends, who were shocked to learn of his sudden death. The bereaved relatives have the sympathy of our people in their sorrow.

Mr. and Mrs. Thomas desire to express their appreciation for the kindness and sympathy tendered them in their deep affliction. They will ever cherish the many acts of kindness done to make their heavy burden less weighty. May God bless all who aided in any way.
