

GEO. A. RENTSCHLER DEAD

Born in Cooper County and Spent His
Whole Life Within Its Borders.

Age 56 Years.

WIFE AND FOUR CHILDREN SURVIVE.

George A. Rentschler died at his farm home a few miles east of Boonville, at what is known as Geyer's Ford, December 20, of pneumonia. Funeral services were held here at the Evangelical church Tuesday afternoon at 2 o'clock, conducted by Rev. R. M. Hinze, the pastor, and interment had at Walnut Grove cemetery.

Mr. Rentschler was born in Cooper county, December 28, 1863, and died at the age of 56 years, lacking only eight days. He is survived by his wife and four children who deeply mourn his death. A brother and one sister also survive. He was the son of John Rentschler, an old citizen of the county and who died a number of years ago.

Mr. Rentschler was an industrious man and an honest citizen. He had the esteem and confidence of all who knew him. His family has the sympathy of all their friends over the loss sustained by the death of the husband and father.
