NO BAIL TO

THE RENNISONS

FATHER AND SON CHARGED
WITH MURDER OF WILL JOBE
HELD IN JAIL PENDING
HEARING.

Bail has been refused Charley Rennison and his son, Rupert, accused of killing William Jobe last Sunday on the Charley Rennison Farm, three miles east of Wana-maker.

Following additional information by W. T. Bellamy, county prosecutor, the two men were brought to Marshall late Thursday afternoon and jointly charged with the murder of Jobe. Rupert Rennison had been previously charged with the crime and released on a bond for \$10,000. Yesterday that bond was cancelled and he and his father are now being held in jail pending the preliminary hearing, which is set for June 1 in the court of John Blair, justice of the peace.
