ACCUSE CHARLEY RENNISON TOO

FOLLOWING ADDITIONAL INFOR-
MATION, FATHER AND SON
JOINTLY CHARGED WITH
DEATH OF WILLIAM JOBE.

Developments have come in the William Jobe murder case following the receipt of additional information by William T. Bellamy, county prosecutor. Information has been filed charging Charley Rennison, father of Rupert Rennison, with part responsibility for the death of Jobe, who was fatally wounded by a pistol shot Sunday noon at the farm of Charley Rennison, three miles east of Wanamaker. Charley Rennison and Jobe married sisters.

A first degree murder charge was placed against Rupert Rennison ~~Tuesday and he was released on a~~ bond for \$10,000. However, an affidavit of information from an eye witness to the shooting caused the prosecutor to charge the father and son jointly with Jobe's death.

John Logsdon, sheriff, left Marshall early this afternoon to bring in the two men on a state warrant. It is probable they will be arraigned late this afternoon.
