

MOTHER AND SON DIE

Mrs. Josephine Hill Dies Tuesday
and Son, Sam Hill, 20, Monday;
Burial Thursday Here

It is quite unusual that the death angel visits the same household twice in one week as it did the Hill home, seven miles south of Boonville this week, taking away first a son and then the mother.

Samuel Hill, 20 years old, died at the family home Monday night following a short illness of diabetes. The mother, Mrs. Josephine Hill, about 50 years old, died Tuesday evening at six o'clock following a long illness but the sudden death of the son is thought to have hastened death.

Mrs. Hill was the wife of the late James H. Hill, who died in September, 1918, and was born and reared in Cooper county. Her death was also due to diabetes.

Mrs. Hill is survived by three children, Mrs. Sam Lankop of Boonville; Mrs. Chris Martin, of Billingsville and Benjamin Hill at home.

The sudden passing of the mother and brother is a great shock to the surviving members of the family and they have the sympathy of all who know them.

The funeral of the mother and son was held together Thursday morning at 11 o'clock at All Herman church, conducted by the Rev. Mr. Baumeyer, pastor of the Tipton Baptist church.

Interment was made at Walnut Grove cemetery in Boonville.
