

SUDDEN DEATH OF OTTERVILLE WOMAN

MRS. SALLIE McNEAL, 82 YEARS
OLD, DIED WEDNESDAY NIGHT

Was Preparing to Retire When End
Came.—She Leaves Five Daughters
and Two Sons.—Funeral Friday

Mrs. Sallie McNeal, widow of the late P. P. McNeal, who died nine years ago, died very suddenly at her home in Otterville Wednesday night about 9 o'clock, while preparing to retire. She had not complained of feeling badly and her death was entirely unexpected.

Funeral services will be held Friday from the family residence, followed by interment at Otterville.
