OBITUARY

JOHN P. NEWELL

John P. Newell, aged 75, a life-long resident of Elkhart county, died at 1:15 o'clock Sunday morning at his home in Bristol. He had been ill of complications for some time, and was bedfast the last month.

The funeral will be held Wednesday, with services at 2 o'clock in the Bristol Methodist church, conducted by Rev. G. E. Luke of Elkhart, pastor of the Indian Creek United Brethren church, of which Mr. Newell was long a member. The burial will take place at Pleasant View cemetery, five miles southeast of Elkhart.

Mr. Newell, the son of Joseph and Elizabeth Newell, pioneers of Elkhart county, was born October 8, 1847, on a farm three miles northeast of Goshen. When his son, J. Edward Newell, was postmaster at Bristol some 15 years ago, the father served as his assistant. Later he returned to farm life, but moved back to Bristol from a place three miles south of Bristol in August 1922.

Surviving him are his second wife, Mrs. Alice J. Newell; the son, J. E. Newell, now of Columbus, O.; Mrs. John Everingham of Bristol; two grandchildren; a brother, James Newell of Erie, Kas., and a sister, Mrs. Elizabeth Carmien of Bristol, besides two stepsons, Arthur Shultz of Chicago and Marvin S. Shultz of Bristol.
