MRS. ANNA NEALE DEAD

Otterville Woman Leaves Husband
and Two Children

Mrs. Anna Neale, wife of Reggie Neale who lives five miles north east of Otterville, died Thursday morning, Dec. 13. Although she had been in delicate health for several years, her death was a shock to her family as she was seriously ill for but a few hours.

Before her marriage, she was Anna Pope, daughter of Mr. and Mrs. Henry Pope. She was born in Bates county, Mo., in 1876. She was married 18 years ago to Reggie Neale, who with the two children, Earl and Leota, survives. There is

also one surviving sister, Mrs. A. T. Hockenberry, of Pisgah.
