Mrs. Kittie Brooks Nichols, widow of the late J. W. Nichols, died at 2:30 o'clock Sunday afternoon at her home five miles northeast of Sedalia after a few days' illness. Her death came as a severe shock to many loving friends and followed the passing of her husband whose death occurred just seven weeks ago, the latter dying after a lingering illness.

Mrs. Nichols was born near Allentown, St. Louis county, September 10, 1864 and when in young womanhood for a time resided in Cooper county, later coming to Pettis county. She was married to Mr. Nichols 34 years ago.
