DEATH OF MRS. NICHOLS

Sixty-two-Year-Old Woman Dies Near
Sedalia Sunday

Mrs. Kathreen Brooks Nichols, widow of the late J. W. Nichols, died Sunday afternoon at her home three miles northeast of Sedalia, following a short illness.

Funeral services were held Wednesday afternoon at 2 o'clock at her home by Rev. R. C. Lippard, pastor of the Sedalia Presbyterian Church, of which she was a devout and faithful member. Burial was in the I. O. O. F. cemetery, Otterville.

Mrs. Nichols was born near Allentown, St. Louis county, September 18, 1864, and came to this part of the state when a young woman. In 1891 she was married to J. W. Nichols, who preceded her in death seven weeks. Mrs. Nichols leaves three sisters and two brothers, Mrs. Stephen Chessbro, of Tuscon, Ariz.; Mrs. Sallie Godby, of Florida; Mrs. Pinkie Gilliam, of Colorado; Thos. Brooks, of Clifton City; John Brooks, of Traction; and many friends.
