Funeral of Mrs. Cook.

The funeral of Mrs. Alice Cook, wife of George H. Cook, residing east of Otterville, was held Saturday afternoon at 2:30 o'clock at the family home, the Rev. L. N. Pollock, pastor of the Methodist Episcopal church, South, of Otterville, officiating. Interment was made in the I. O. O. F. cemetery.

Mrs. Cook was born October 15, 1864, near California, Mo. She was married to George H. Cook on February 15, 1883. Of this union six children were born, all of whom survive. They are O. L. Cook of Chilhowee, Mrs. Maude Thomas of Sedalia, Earl, Norville and Wesley Cook and Mrs. Edith Rennison, all of the home; also a granddaughter, Edna Mae Cook, who was reared by Mr. and Mrs. George H.
