

Mrs. R. S. Cary, Speed, Dies Sunday

Leaves Husband and Nine Children, Two Brothers and One Sister.—Funeral Tuesday

Mrs. R. S. Cary, who lived two miles north of Speed, died Sunday evening at eleven o'clock. Funeral services were held at the home Tuesday afternoon at two o'clock, followed by burial in Moore cemetery.
