

Nicholas Smith of Lone Elm Is Dead

Native of Germany Passed Away
at Home of Son, Arthur Smith,
Sunday Morning

Nicholas Smith died Sunday Aug. 9 at the home of his son, Arthur Smith, in the Lone Elm community, after a illness of several years. Funeral services were held at Clark's Fork Lutheran church Tuesday morning at 10 o'clock, conducted by the Rev. A. A. Falke, pastor of the church. Burial was made in the church cemetery. Pall bearers were: Grover and O. K. Toler, Raymond Smith, Ollie Theiss, Edgar Pethan, and Waldo Langkop.

Mr. Smith was born in Germany April 5, 1868, and came to this country when about four years old. On March 9, 1876, he married Louise Gentry, who died ten years later. He was married to Margaret Toler, Dec. 27, 1888, who died in 1907. One child was born to this union, Arthur Smith, who survives his father. A granddaughter, Marjorie Smith, and a sister, Mrs. Maria Langkop, also survive.
