

Miss Arzelia Smith Of Boonville Dies

Native of Community Was Born In
Cooper County 91 Years
Ago

Miss Arzelia Smith, 91 years old, a life-long resident of Boonville and this community, died last night at 12:30 o'clock at her home at 403 Fourth street. She had been in falling health for several years.

Miss Smith was born April 20, 1840, on the farm 4 1/2 miles south-east of Boonville where she made her home until 1918, when, with her sister, Miss Ada Smith, who survives her, she moved to Boonville. She was a daughter of the late David and Sophia Smith, pioneers of the county. She was educated at Convent Ste. Genevieve. She was a life long member of the Cumberland Presbyterian church. Three sisters preceded her in death.

Funeral services will be held at the home Sunday afternoon at 3 o'clock and will be in charge of the Rev. I. D. Borders, pastor of the Boonville Presbyterian church.
