J. G. HOWARD DIED FRIDAY AT TIPTON

John G. Howard, for many years a respected citizen of Tipton, died at 12:05 o'clock Friday morning at the home of his son-in-law and daughter, Mr. and Mrs. Athel Hays. His illness, following a paralytic stroke, was of several weeks duration.

Mr. Howard was born in Morgan County, on October 8, 1851, and his entire life has been spent in this community. He engaged most successfully in farming, and in 1927, he retired, coming to Tipton, where he built one of the substantial homes of the town.

In 1881 he married Miss Alice Woods and they were the parents of one child, Ethel, now Mrs. Athel Hays. Mrs. Howard died two years ago, since which time Mr. Howard has been cared for in his daughter's home. There are four grandchildren, Misses Alice and Virginia Hays, of the home, Mrs. Earl

Evans, of Carrollton; and Howard Hays, also at home. There is a brother, Wade H. Howard, of Sedalia, and a sister, Mrs. Dixie Mathew, of Tipton.

Mr. Howard was a man of retiring life, interested in his own affairs, and those of his family, to whom he was deeply devoted. He

was a member of the Christian church, and the funeral services honoring him will be held there Sunday afternoon at 2:00 o'clock by the pastor, Rev. J. L. Freeman. Interment will be in the family lot in the Masonic cemetery.
