Francis Marion Garrett Dies
Francis Marion Garrett, 76 years old, pioneer resident of Pettis county, passed away suddenly about 4:45 o'clock Wednesday morning following a heart attack.

Mr. Garrett was born March 14, 1862. He has resided at his present address on route two, Sedalia, for the past 47 years.

He was a member of the Pleasant Hill church.

He was married January 30, 1932, to Ellen Haley, who survives as do two sons and three daughters Oliver and Wilbur Garrett, Mrs. Armeda Eichholz, Mrs. James Moore and Mrs. Viola O'Leary, all of Sedalia. One daughter, Mrs. Bertie Johnson, passed away February 11, 1922.

Three wives preceded him in death.

Also surviving are three brothers, J. W., T. M., and C. E. Garrett, one sister, Mrs. Alice Corley, all of Sedalia. Twenty-one grandchildren and two great-grandchildren survive.

Funeral services will be held at the Pleasant Hill church at 2:30 o'clock this afternoon. Burial will be in the church cemetery.
