Robert Wadlow, the biggest man in the world, will be at the Boonville Shoe Store, from 4 to 5 o'clock p. m., May 9, according to an announcement by Carl Barnert, manager of the store.

Robert is 21 years of age, is 8 feet, 9½ inches tall and weighs 491 pounds. He wears a size 37 shoe made for him by the Peters Shoe Company whose line is handled here by Mr. Barnert.

It is said that Robert's shoes are the largest ever made for a human foot. Each shoe weighs 4 pounds and is 19 inches long.
