Harley H. Huff Dies At Parkville

Funeral Services For Former
Slater Resident Will be
Sunday Afternoon at Slater

Harley H. Huff, a former resident of Slater, died Friday morning at the home of his daughter, Mrs. Frances Riley at Parkville, at the age of 59 years. He had suffered for sometime from a heart ailment and died while sitting in his chair.

He was the son of Ephriam and Frances Huff and was born near Good Hope, the greater part of his life being spent in that community and in Slater. For many years he was a buyer and shipper of walnut logs and was well known throughout the county. He is survived by the wife, the daughter and one grand child of the home and a sister, Mrs. Katie Dulsen of Kansas City, Kansas.
